Key Characters

Aunt Evelyn Johnson. A respectable widow and tennis player in Bridlington.



Amy Johnson (b. 1903). Ciss and Andrew's eldest daughter. A headstrong rebel throughout her school days. Suffers from black moods and bad period pains.



Irene Johnson (b. 1904). Amy's younger sister. Suffers badly from depression, and wants to be an actress. Has a fraught relationship with Amy. Amy did not attend her wedding. Irene marries young and then commits suicide in 1929.



Molly Johnson (b. 1912). In awe of her older sisters.




Betty Johnson (b. 1919). Kept Amy's flame alive in later life.

The story takes place between 1921 and 1929.



SHE REGULARLY PLAYED TRUANT FROM SCHOOL, AND RAN AWAY FROM HOME ON MANY OCCASIONS


























IN 1925 AMY HAD A NERVOUS BREAKDOWN ...




















